Consideration and possible action regarding the approval of the Minutes for the Regular Board Meeting held on August 18, 2021.

A Motion was made by Mark Freeland and seconded by Lance Neuhaus to approve the Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting held on August 18, 2021. Revisions were made by Attorney Randy Whittington on the inclusions on Lance Neuhaus 'properties and other annexation of irrigable properties into the District's boundaries.

Consideration and possible action regarding the financial reports and the approval of accounts payable checks.

Wednesday, September 8, 2021 at 12:00 p.m.

A Motion was made by Mark Freeland and seconded by Lance Neuhaus to approve the Account Payable Checks and to table the Financial Reports by Ewing & Lara.

Motion Carried and Financial Reports Item Tabled.

There was a decision to move the Board meetings to the 3rd Wednesday of the month to give ample time for Ewing and Lara to have the Financial Reports ready before the meetings.

General Report by President

President Othal Brand, Jr. reported that the District paid off the Line of Credit at the Texas Regional Bank. (See attachment A-Line of Credit letter)

President Othal Brand, Jr. discussed the ongoing progress in the Office Building Renovation and the decision to include sprinklers in the office in case of a fire.

The City of Hidalgo cracked the District irrigation 18- inch pipeline while they were working on the City water and sewer line project.

Carmen De Leon reported to the Board that the District pumped 760.00 acre feet and 745.00 acre feet into Lake Boeye Reservoir for the month of September.

Engineering Report

Water Report

Engineer Frank Ferris informed the Board that the District's storage balance at the beginning of the September Period was 4,670 acre feet or 38.7 percent of the maximum Storage Balance. The usable balance is 4,206 acre feet, being 49.2 percent of the annual water right. The U.S. share is down to 39.5 percent as of August 28.

Consideration and possible action to declare as surplus property a certain 300 square foot easement out of Lot 10 Section 4, Hidalgo Canal Company Subdivision, Hidalgo County, Texas.

A Motion was made by Mark Freeland and seconded by Lance Neuhaus to declare as surplus a 15x20 right-of-way easement property out of Lot 10 Section 4 Hidalgo Canal Company Subdivision and the surplus to be sold or exchanged for fair market value according to District Engineer Frank Ferris.

Consideration and possible action to release a 300 square foot easement out of Lot 10, Section 4, Hidalgo Canal Company Subdivision, Hidalgo County, Texas.

A Motion was made by Lance Neuhaus and seconded by Mark Freeland to release a 300 square foot easement out of Lot 10, Section 4, Hidalgo Canal Company Subdivision, Hidalgo County,

Texas in exchange by the grantee for payment to the District of reasonable expenses incurred by District engineer and attorney in the evaluation and preparation of the release.

Consideration and possible action to amend the District's Utility License Guidelines and Fee Schedule.

A Motion was made by Mark Freeland and seconded by W.D. Moschel to table this item pending further review at the next regular board meeting.

Consideration and possible action regarding the District's interest in Lot 4, Block 2, Fairway South Subdivision, Hidalgo County, Texas.

A Motion was made by W.D. Moschel and seconded by Mark Freeland to approve a letter by District's engineer, Mr. Ferris regarding District's interest on Lot 4 Block 2 Fairway South Subdivision, Hidalgo County, Texas.

Consideration and possible action regarding the District's interest in Lot 1 Dollar General Subdivision, Hidalgo County, Texas.

A Motion was made by Lance Neuhaus and seconded by Mark Freeland to approve the District's interest in Lot 1 Dollar General Subdivision and to authorize District Engineer Frank Ferris to send a letter that in addition, includes information related to the presence of Lateral R next to their property.

Consideration and possible action regarding the District's interest in 2.07 acre Tract out of Lot 17, Unit 1 Ebony Heights Citrus Groves Subdivision, Hidalgo, County, Texas.

Having previously filed an affidavit with the District disclosing his interest in the real property which is the subject of the petition, Othal Brand, Jr. abstained and did not participate in the consideration of the petition or vote on the matter of setting a hearing on the petition.

An inclusion petition was also filed by Pompeyo Quesada Trejo to annex his property 1127 Harvey, and 1128 Harvey into the District. The hearing on the petitions should take place at The Regular Board Meeting on October 20, 2021. A Motion was made by Lance Neuhaus and Seconded by Moschel to approve the Order setting Hearing on the above petitions.

No other petitions for annexation of property having been filed A Motion was made by Mark Freeland and seconded by Lance Neuhaus to table the consideration of additional petitions for annexation of irrigable properties into District's boundaries until the next regular board meeting.
