Engineering Report

Engineer Frank Ferris reported the usable balance at the beginning of September was 3,079 acre feet, being 36% of the annual water right, and 25% of the Storage Balance, after repayment of the negative allocation of about 342 acre feet. Recent rain in the watershed will result in repayment of the negative allocation, another possible additional allocation in the next few days and an allocation of 10-20% by mid-November. The US share has risen to 28.6 % as of September 10, 2022. The City has not taken any municipal water since June, but 4,039 acre feet remain on their contract this calendar year.

The District has irrigated 126 acres since implementing the allocation program. There is sufficient water in the District's adjudication account to meet the current allocation to the District's adjudication account to meet the current allocation to District users. The recent rains will likely result in additional allocation to District users, but the District will remain on allocation for the next few months.
