#### **Engineering Report**

a) Report on District allocation in the Falcon & Amistad Reservoir System.

Engineer Frank Ferris reported that the District received an allocation of 3.55 % acre feet for the February Period. The District began the month with a Usable Balance of 3.171 acre feet, amounting to 37 of the annual water right, and 26% of the storage balance. The US share is up to 22.3% as of February 3<sup>rd</sup>.

- d) McAllen South Industrial Park-Irrigation lines have been installed and construction of the well have begun.
- e) City of McAllen South 10<sup>th</sup> Street Drainage Improvements –Proceed with the repairs the next time the pipeline is utilized and seek to recover damages from the responsible party(ies).

(iv) a pending McAllen Public Utility petition filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas appealing wholesale water rates of Hidalgo County Water Imp.
